



Residents With Water Wells Affected by Flood Waters

The Lake County Health Department/Community Health Center urges residents on private wells to have their water tested **after the floodwaters have receded**. If a well casing is or has been submerged, surface water may have entered the well and contaminated the drinking water. In these cases, the water should not be consumed until it is tested and shown to meet drinking water standards.

The Health Department has three regional offices where sterile bottles may be obtained to be filled and returned for analysis, and where information is available about disinfecting contaminated water wells. The offices are open from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
